Instruction Manual

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- * NEVER INSTALL TELEPHONE WIRING DURING A LIGHTNING STORM.
- * NEVER INSTALL TELEPHONE JACKS IN WET LOCATIONS, UNLESS THE JACK IS SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED FOR WET LOCATIONS.
- * NEVER TOUCH UNINSULATED TELEPHONE WIRES OR TERMINALS, UNLESS THE TELEPHONE LINE HAS BEEN DISCONNECTED AT THE NETWORK INTERFACE
- * DO NOT PLACE THIS PRODUCT ON AN UNSTABLE CART, STAND OR TABLE. THE PRODUCT MAY FALL, CAUSING DAMAGE TO THE PRODUCT.

2. INSTALLATION

- * CONNECT THE TELEPHONE HANDSET CORD TO THE HANDSET JACK (1).
- * CONNECT THE TELEPHONE LINE CORD TO THE LINE JACK (RJ11C) (2). TO ENSURE PROPER CONNECTION. PRESS THE LOCKING TAB FIRMLY INTO THE MODULAR JACK UNTIL A CLICK IS HEARD.

3. ADJUSTMENT

- * SET THE HANDSET'S RECEIVER VOLUME CONTROL SELECTOR (3) TO HIGH OR LOW LEVEL ACCORDING TO YOUR PERSONAL HEARING PREFERENCE
- * SET THE RINGER VOLUME LEVEL SELEVTOR (4) TO THE HIGH (LOUD) OR LOW ACCORDING TO YOUR OWN PREFERENCE.

4. OPERATIONS

- * MAKING CALLS.
REMOVE THE RECEIVER FROM THE CRADLE.
PRESS THE NUMERICAL BUTTON TO DIAL THE DESIRED NUMBERS.
- * RECEIVING CALLS.
WHEN CALLS INCOMING, LIFT THE RECEIVER FROM THE CRADLE AND TALK INTO THE MOUTHPIECE TO BEGIN YOUR CONVERSATION.
TO TERMINATE THE CONVERSATION, REPLACE THE RECEIVER BACK TO THE CRADLE
- * LAST NUMBER REDIAL.
IF THE LAST NUMBER DIALED WAS ENGAGED, PRESS THE CENTER MEDALLION REDIAL BUTTON (5) TO CALL IT AGAIN.

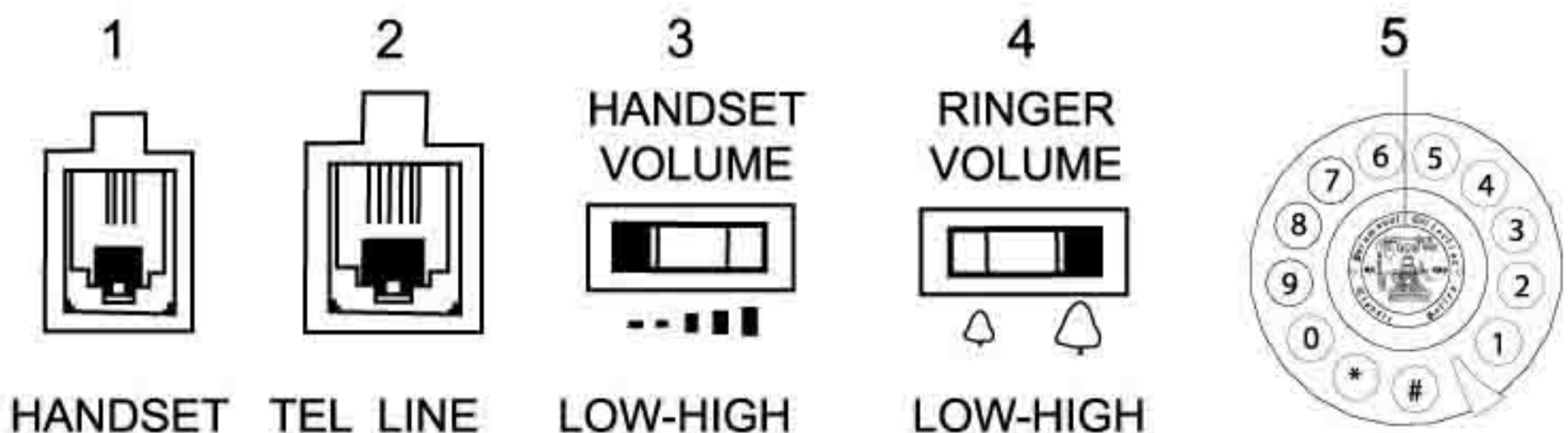
*PARTY-LINE SYSTEMS

Product Warranty

Antique Reproductions Guarantees your product for 12 months from date of purchase against any defect in materials or workmanship under conditions of normal use and service and subject to proof of the date of purchase being provided and subject to the conditions specified below.

The benefits conferred by this warranty are in addition to all other rights and remedies in respect of the product that the consumer has under the Trade Practices Act and similar State and Territory laws.

Warranty Service Conditions

Subject to your statutory rights referred to above, Antique Reproductions expressly limits its liability with respect to its products to the person who purchases the Product from the Antique Reproductions authorised retailer.

Subject to your statutory rights referred to above, Antique Reproductions expressly limits its liability with respect to its products to whichever is the lowest amount out of:

- A. The cost of having the goods repaired
- B. The cost of replacing the goods: or
- C. The cost of obtaining equivalent goods.

Subject to your statutory rights referred to above, in the event of the goods requiring service under warranty, the owner is responsible for the cost of transportation to the authorised service organisation. Whilst in transit the goods are at the owner's risk.

Subject to your statutory rights referred to above, should the goods be found to be in sound working order by the authorised service organisation the owner may be charged a service fee.

Subject to your statutory rights referred to above, the goods will not be eligible for service under this warranty if:

- A. Proof of date of purchase cannot be provided;
- B. The goods are not branded Antique Reproductions;
- C. The defect was caused by an accident, misuse, abuse, improper installation or operation, lack of reasonable care, unauthorised modification, loss of parts, tampering or attempted repair by a person not authorised by Antique Reproductions.
- D. The product has been damaged by lightning or a Mains power surge.
